

**Applications are invited for training on "Methods for documentation of biodiversity"
scheduled from 03 to 05 September 2024 at ICFRE - IFB, Hyderabad**

ICFRE-Institute of Forest Biodiversity, Hyderabad is organizing **offline training** on "**Methods for documentation of biodiversity**" scheduled from **03 to 05 September 2024**. The 3-days Capacity Building Training is funded by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India under the Scheme - "*Forestry Training and Capacity Building*" for Training of Other Stakeholders. Target group for the training is students from educational institutions, nature clubs, ecoclubs, NGOs and social activists.

The training is a combination of classroom and field sessions and includes following topics - Methods for documenting and quantification of flora, avifauna, wetlands, Basics of GIS & RS along with GPS handling and map making, Tools for biodiversity data analysis.

Information for the applicants:

1. Maximum 30 applicants will be selected based on the application response
2. Last date to submit application is 08.07.2024
3. Selected candidates will be informed by 15.07.2024
4. Confirmation of participation should be received by 22.07.2024 failing which selection will be cancelled without any intimation to accommodate other interested applicant
5. No fee payment is required for the training
6. Participants will have to arrange for their transport to the venue and return. Travels made by using public transport (Train up to Sleeper Class, Bus non-AC) through shortest route will be reimbursed on submission of tickets in original, ADHAAR as ID Proof and Bank Account details
7. Accommodation and local transport arrangements for the training days will be arranged by the organizers
8. Candidates should report to the venue by 02.09.2024 evening and plan departure after 6.00 pm on 05.09.2024
9. Candidates who have already attended training organized in 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 are not eligible to apply again
10. Candidates need to carry their own laptop for hands-on sessions
